

Frequency list of Swahili words¹

Compiled by Arvi Hurskainen, University of Helsinki

In this location, there are ten frequency lists of Swahili, each with 1000 words.

This frequency list contains **words between 9001 and 10000** in Swahili frequency list. The list is based on a corpus of 9.298.792 Swahili words. The corpus was composed mostly of news texts, but also some fiction, scientific texts, religious texts (Catholic), official government texts, reports and speeches, were included.

The total list, from which this list was extracted, contains 39256 entries.

The list was produced using SALAMA (<http://www.njas.helsinki.fi/salama>). The system disambiguates words according to their function and partly also according to their meaning. Therefore, the same word may be found more than one time in the list.

In this list, verb extensions have been included as separate entries. Only passive forms have been transformed into active forms, and they are listed together with their active counterparts.

For saving space, the number of English glosses was restricted to one.

The list contains also multi-word expressions (tag: MW), which are treated as separate entries.
